

Call for Applications for DAFI Scholarship For Afghan Refugee Students in Pakistan 2017-18

Inspire Pakistan in collaboration with UNCHR invites applications for the German Government funded Albert Einstein Refugee Initiative (DAFI) for the year 2017-18.

Eligibility Criteria

- Valid POR card holder
- Age between 17 to 30 years
- Holding a Higher Secondary School Certificate (HSSC/Intermediate)
- Enrolled in HEC recognized institutions
- Candidate must have at least 60% marks in last examination
- The applicant must be the only beneficiary of DAFI from his/ her family
- The applicant should not have received an academic scholarship in the past
- Strong motivation to contribute to your community
- Interest in a professional qualification

Documents to be provided with the Application Form

- Completed DAFI Application Form
- Valid POR card
- Matriculation and intermediate certificates with DMCs
- Proof of enrollment in institute (Admission Letter/ Bonafide Letter)
- Equivalence Certificate for students who have studied from Afghan schools

The applications forms should be submitted to the DAFI Project Manager - Inspire Pakistan Head Office House No. 351, Street No. 72, Sector G-11/2 Islamabad by hand or by courier on/before **17 November 2017**. Please note that application forms are free of charge. Incomplete application forms will be not entertained.

Please note that only shortlisted candidates will be contacted on the numbers provided in the application forms and invited for interviews in Islamabad, Peshawar, Karachi and Quetta respectively.

Pakistani students are not eligible for the scholarship. Students trying to influence the selection process will be automatically disqualified.

We encourage qualified female candidates and refugees with special needs to apply.
